**RESOLUTION 2026 - 6**

WHEREAS Damascus Township Board of Supervisors enacted a Zoning Ordinance in 1980 in accordance with the Municipalities Planning Code (P.L. 805, No. 247, as amended); and

WHEREAS said Ordinance has undergone several Amendments; and


WHEREAS Damascus Township does not desire to prevent Data Center projects within the Township, but does desire to protect the neighboring properties and the Township as a whole from projects that could negatively impact the Township and its property owners; and


WHEREAS Damascus Township does desire to study, and develop reasonable regulations for Data Centers (AI facilities), including, but not limited to, the space requirements, power requirements, water usage requirements, impact on the local electric grid and water table, power generators of any type to supply these data centers, stormwater management, noise pollution, light pollution, water pollution, local employment, and health and safety hazards associated with said projects; and


WHEREAS Damascus Township desires to amend the Zoning Ordinance to attain the goals stated herein; now

THEREFORE the Board of Supervisors resolves to declare an extension of a Moratorium on any applications for Data Center and associated projects from this date for a period of One Hundred Eighty (180) days, or until a Zoning Amendment is enacted previous to that date, and which Moratorium may be extended for further study as deemed necessary.


